PLAN B

The Sellers

Step 1: Pick up a "Check Card" at the LCJ Entrance and fills in their name and phone number;

Step 2: Give the Check Card and textbook(s) to **Charles until 4/6 (Mon.)**; he will write down the book's condition on the check card;

Step 3: The S.A.B. keeps the card on file.

The Buyers

Step 1: Sign up at 6F: write your name, phone number, textbook name you want, and A/B/C level you want.

Then, **Come To B1 on The Sale Day!!!**

NIC students can use this system, too.

The S.A.B. takes no fee.

*You can buy & sell **textbook(s) only listed on the Price Sheet** below, which you can take in every term.

When a buyer asks the S.A.B. for that text, the S.A.B. will arrange the sale on the sale day, so the sellers make sure that **the buyers NOT ALWAYS be found.
